ROLE TITLE: Head Coach Wakefield Trinity Women's Rugby League

The Head Coach will be responsible for high-quality coaching delivery to the WSL athletes. Working in collaboration with the Head of Foundation (HoF), CEO, Team Manager, and Coaching staff to formulate a clear playing philosophy and plan to take the team forward.

The Head Coach will be instrumental in providing a positive environment that helps develop all players and staff to compete successfully in the Betfred Women's Super League and Betfred Challenge Cup competitions.

You will be responsible for all on-field coaching requirements for the Wakefield Trinity Women's team and delegation to support coaching staff to ensure that all players and staff can fulfill their own roles effectively through our long-term strategy.

As part of the management team, you will be a positive influencer for the players and other core staff members. There is an expectation that all staff will adhere to the codes of conduct, vision, mission, and core values of Wakefield Trinity Rugby League.

Key Responsibilities:

- Provide effective leadership for the players and staff with a clear coaching philosophy.
- Developing each player to their maximum potential by encouraging excellence in execution at all times and providing positive feedback and post-game analysis to the players and staff
- Effectively liaise and communicate with players, coach's, supporters, and Wakefield Trinity.
- Work closely with support staff & coaching team, ensure a clear requirement of S&C and medical are implemented.
- Ensure that are players that are required to move between teams (Academy & WSL) are communicated positively in a timely and effective manner that ensures the positive morale and required outcome for the player/team
- Responsible in conjunction with the HoF, CEO, and Team Manager with them to recruit and retain players.
- Positively promote the profile of Wakefield Trinity & rugby league as a whole
- Effective communicator, able to build and maintain good relationships with all players, volunteers, leagues, NGB & Wakefield Trinity RLFC

You will be suitably qualified to a minimum of UKCC Level 2, ideally Level 3. The successful applicant will need to undertake an enhanced DBS check and also relevant training linked to safeguarding.
